



**Frequently Asked Questions
about the scholarship application process**

1. Do I need to complete separate application forms?

- ✓ Yes, each scholarship requires you to complete the appropriate application form.
- ✓ Read the instructions carefully and remember to write clearly.

2. Where do I find the application forms?

✓ For scholarships offered by the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technologies application forms can be downloaded from: **<http://www.eng.usyd.edu.au/scholarships>**

✓ For the University of Sydney Scholarships there is only one application form and it can be downloaded from: **www.usyd.edu.au/scholarships**

✓ If you are eligible to apply, complete and return the appropriate application forms by **26 September 2008**. Remember you must apply separately for admission to the relevant Engineering & IT course(s) at the University of Sydney through the Universities Admission Centre (UAC). Details of how to do this are in the *UAC Guide 2009*.

- ✓ Unfortunately, faxed and emailed applications will not be accepted.

3. Can I still apply for a scholarship if I want to do a combined degree?

✓ Yes, most scholarships allow you the option of enrolling in a combined degree. In some cases the financial support may not cover the final year of your degree. Although, you would have the opportunity to apply for one of our many later year scholarships to cover your final year.

4. What do I do if I do not have my trial results before the closing date?

✓ If you do not have your trial results in time please still send your application by Friday 26 September 2008. However, you must include a covering note clearly indicating when your results will be available. Once, you have received your results from your school please fax them to us on 9351 4654. Late results should be sent no later than **Friday 10 October 2008**.

5. Do I receive a confirmation stating that my application has been processed?

✓ If you are applying for more than one scholarship in the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technologies you may send all your application forms in the same envelope. All applications received will be acknowledged with an email from the Engineering & IT Scholarships Office.

6. When do you hold interviews and how do you contact short-listed applicants?

- ✓ Interviews are usually held between **in the first week of December 2008**.
- ✓ Short-listed applicants are contacted via email.

7. What happens if I am going away and I cannot attend an interview?

✓ Applications are ranked according to academic achievement and personal attributes as presented in the application. If you know you will be away during this please include a covering note to your application form clearly stating you will be away.

✓ You should include a telephone number (preferably a mobile number) and an email address which we can contact you on. This way we can arrange an interview via telephone if required.
