Group Presentation Guidelines

Organisation

- The presentation is timed for 12 minutes, with 3 minutes for questions
- The presentation should be supported by PowerPoint slides etc – we recommend an absolute maximum of 8 slides for a 12 minute presentation
- A printout of the presentation should be handed to the lecturer at the start of the presentation
- There must be a minimum of two presenters, and a maximum of four, from each group

Content

- Select an engineering project, from about the last 5 years; it can be from any country/region, provided you can access sufficient reliable information.
- Research the engineering project in terms of **one** of the following professional engineering practice dimensions:
 - technological
 - economic
 - environmental
 - financial
 - regulatory
 - ethical
 - managerial
- These dimensions are likely to overlap, but you should focus predominantly on only one
- Your presentation should:
 - briefly describe the project
 - explain why the engineering practice was chosen and why it was important in the project
 - analyse the role of the engineering practice in the project
 - draw some lessons or broad conclusions
